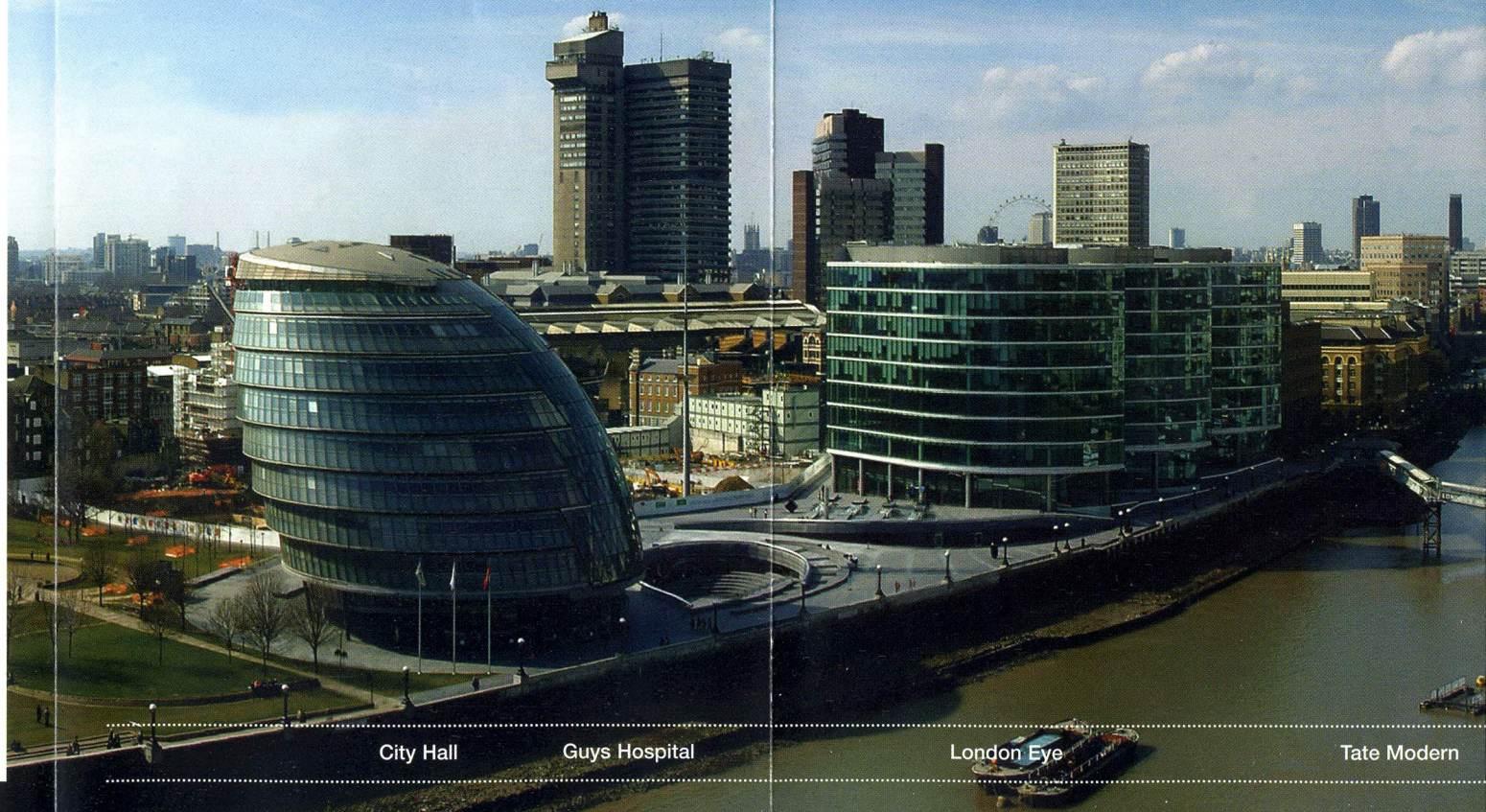
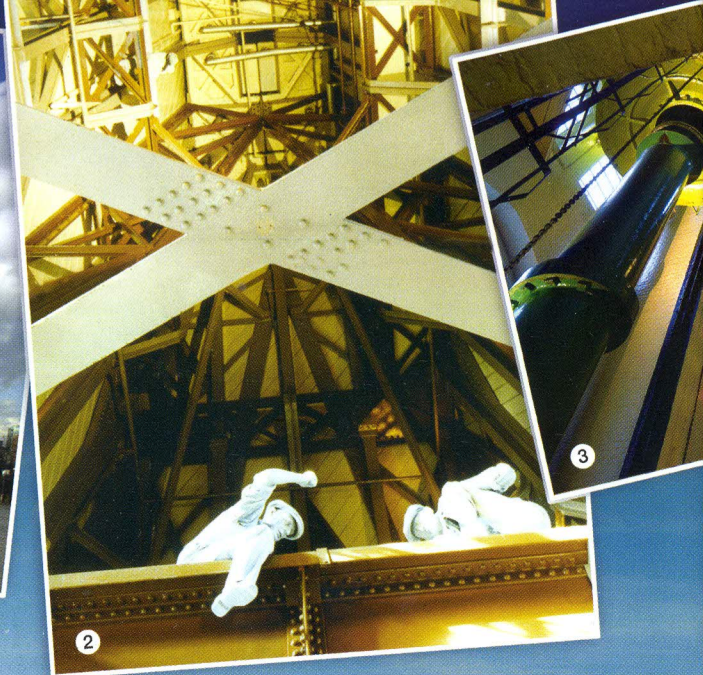


Look out on London... Step into history

Tower Bridge, one of London's most famous landmarks, was constructed at the end of the 19th Century. It stands as striking testimony to the vision and skills of the Victorian engineers involved in its conception. Two Walkways were built to link the spectacular Gothic towers allowing foot passengers to cross over the River Thames, whilst the roadway was lifted upwards to allow tall ships to enter the Pool of London. Now in the 21st Century these glass-covered Walkways can still be accessed and act as viewing galleries across an ever changing London skyline.

Over the last 23 years Tower Bridge Exhibition has seen over 10 million visitors marvel at the spectacular views and learn about the history of the Bridge, and how it was built, from interactive displays and films. The final part of the visit is in the Victorian Engine Rooms, popular with children and adults alike. Visitors will discover the practical side of the Bridge through the use of hands-on models and talking boxes.
